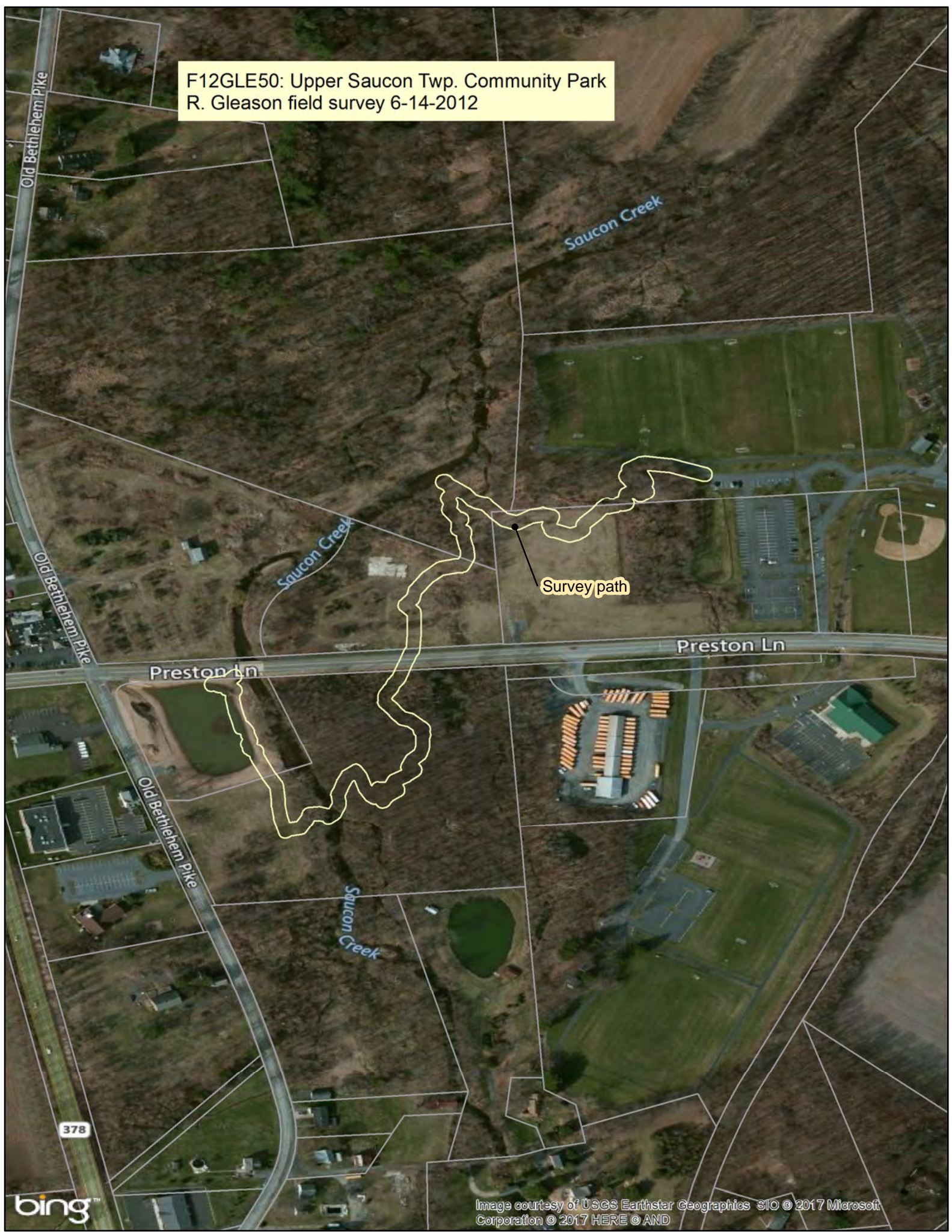


F12GLE50: Upper Saucon Twp. Community Park

DESCRIPTION: Scattered moist wooded areas and mowed meadows adjacent to active athletic park. Most of the Upper Saucon Twp owned property here is utilized as active park facilities. There is a nice bottomland hickory-dominated forest south of Preston Lane, with many larger shagbark hickories and decent tree regeneration. The understory shrub and herbaceous layers are weedy and introduced species should be controlled. The mowed grassy areas on the north side of Preston Lane had some indication of wetness, and could support good plant diversity if mowing occurred less frequently. Additional surveys could be conducted along Saucon Creek on adjacent private property, and land owned by DeSales University.
