Resolution No. 2016-26 – Grant Application For Intersection Improvements at Route 309 and Lanark Road

Motion made by Mr. Benner and seconded by Mr. Spaeth to adopt Resolution No. 2016-26 authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Commonwealth Financing Authority for the purpose of obtaining funding to assist with the construction of traffic improvements at the intersection of Route 309 and Lanark Road.

Change Orders for Park Trail Relocation & Extension Project

Mr. Beil said there were four Change Orders for the Board to consider. He reviewed the Change Orders and explained why they were needed.

<u>Change Order #1 – Replace existing asphalt walkways near concession stand</u>
Motion made by Mr. Benner and seconded by Mr. Spaeth to approve Change Order No. 1 for the Park Trail Relocation & Extension Project resulting in a net increase of \$4,300 to the original contract price.

The motion was approved by a vote of 3 to 0.

<u>Change Order #2 – Excavate wet soil from Trail A and replace with #4 stone</u>
Motion made by Mr. Benner and seconded by Mr. Spaeth to approve Change Order No. 2 for the Park Trail Relocation & Extension Project resulting in a net increase of \$2,500 to the original contract price.

The motion was approved by a vote of 3 to 0.

Change Order #3 – Lower underground electric wire for parking lot lights

Motion made by Mr. Benner and seconded by Mr. Spaeth to approve Change Order No. 3 for the Park Trail Relocation & Extension Project resulting in a net increase of up to \$500 to the original contract price.

The motion was approved by a vote of 3 to 0.

Change Order #4 – Install red stone between Trail A and parking lot

Motion made by Mr. Benner and seconded by Mr. Spaeth to approve Change Order No. 4 for the Park Trail Relocation & Extension Project resulting in a net increase of \$850 to the original contract price.

The motion was approved by a vote of 3 to 0.

<u>PRESENTATION BY REBECCA CLOUSER OF REINSEL KUNTZ LESHER LP –</u> 2015 ANNUAL AUDIT OF TOWNSHIP ACCOUNTS

Review Agenda for Zoning Hearing Board meeting on August 1, 2016

Mr. Beil reviewed the two appeals on the docket for the August 1, 2016 Zoning Hearing Board meeting. It was determined both appeals involve routine matters that can be handled by the Zoning Hearing Board without input from the Board of Supervisors.

Copperhead Grille – request to rezone properties at 5737 Rt. 378 and 5706 Old Bethlehem Pike from Suburban Residential (R-2) to Commercial (C).

Attorney Kate Durso was present on behalf of the owners of the Copperhead Grille. She explained the Copperhead Grille is interested in acquiring the property at 5706 Old Bethlehem Pike which is located immediately north of the existing Copperhead Grille property. The Copperhead Grille would like to demolish the existing home on the property at 5706 Old Bethlehem Pike and construct a new parking lot to serve their existing restaurant. The property at 5706 Old Bethlehem Pike is currently zoned Suburban Residential (R-2), and parking lots are not permitted in this zoning district. Attorney Durso asked the Board to consider rezoning the property at 5706 Old Bethlehem Pike, as well as the Copperhead Grille property at 5737 Route 378, from Suburban Residential (R-2) to Commercial (C). Parking lots are permitted in the Commercial (C) zoning district. As an alternative to having the properties rezoned to Commercial (C), Attorney Durso suggested the Board consider adding the properties to the Village Commercial Overlay Zone (VC). Restaurants and parking lots are permitted in the Village Commercial Overlay Zone (VC).

Chris Garges of 5650 Old Bethlehem Pike spoke in opposition to the Copperhead Grille's rezoning request. Mr. Garges said he lives immediately north of the property where the new parking lot is proposed. He was concerned that the proposed parking lot would adversely affect his quality of life and decrease the value of his property.

It was the consensus of the Board to refer this matter to the Planning and Zoning Committee. Mr. Beil noted that Mr. Wagner, one of the members of this Committee, will likely be out of the area for several weeks on business. Mr. Benner offered to fill in for Mr. Wagner. A meeting of the Planning and Zoning Committee was tentatively scheduled for Monday, August 1 at 5:00 p.m. at the Township Building. Attorney Durso and Mr. Garges indicated they were available to attend the meeting.
