Increase Compensation of Township Tax Collector

Mr. Beil said he received a request from the Township Tax Collector for the Board of Supervisors to increase the Tax Collector's rate of compensation effective January 1, 2018. He said the last increase occurred in January of 2014.

A discussion ensued concerning the Tax Collector's compensation.

It was the consensus of the Board to refer this matter to the Finance and Administration Committee for further review. The Committee will recommend an appropriate rate of compensation for the Tax Collector and the full Board will act on the Committee's recommendation prior to February 15, 2017.
