## **DIRECTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Request by Victor Vardaro to reduce speed limit from 40 mph to 35 mph on Route 309 northbound between Route 378 and Camp Meeting Road

<u>Victor Vardaro, 6087 Main Street</u> – Mr. Vardaro spoke in favor of reducing the speed limit from 40 mph to 35 mph on Route 309 northbound between Route 378 and Camp Meeting Road. He noted State Representative Simmons recently wrote a letter to the Township in support of the speed limit reduction.

Mr. Vardaro said it was PennDOT's expert opinion to reduce the speed limit and the Board should follow PennDOT's advice.

Chairman Wagner said PennDOT is entitled to reduce the speed limit on its own because Route 309 is a State road. He said it appears PennDOT does not wish to unilaterally lower the speed limit and is leaving the matter up to the Township.

Mr. Leonard said he would be fine with lowering the speed limit, although the other Board members do not seem inclined to do so. He asked Mr. Vardaro if keeping the speed limit at 40 mph but installing enhanced speed limit signs along this stretch of highway would be acceptable.

Mr. Vardaro said he would be willing to accept what Mr. Leonard proposed.

Motion made by Mr. Leonard and seconded by Mr. Benner to authorize the Township Manager to approach PennDOT to gain approval for posting enhanced 40 mph speed limit signs on Route 309 northbound between Route 378 and Camp Meeting Road at the Township's cost.

The motion was approved by a vote of 5 to 0.
