CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman Benner called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., in the Public Meeting Room of the Upper Saucon Township Municipal Building, 5500 Camp Meeting Road, Upper Saucon Township, Lehigh County, PA.

The safety improvements included installing bigger speed limit signs and stepping up traffic enforcement activities. Mr. Vardaro said the signs and increased police presence have been effective in slowing traffic.

Mr. Wagner explained his opposition to Ms. Stehlik's appointment to the Board of Supervisors.

Mr. Spaeth spoke in support of Ms. Stehlik's appointment to the Board. He was very impressed with Ms. Stehlik's energy, interest in young people and interest in promoting recreation. He said all seven applicants who applied for the position were great and any one of them would do a good job serving on the Board.

The motion was approved by a vote of 3 to 1. Messrs. Benner, Spaeth and Farrell voted in favor of the motion. Mr. Wagner voted against the motion.

The revisions were minor and did not change in any way the recommendations of the original Study.
