ORDINANCE NO. 68-A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER SAUCON, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 68, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF AND REGISTRATION OF ALL AUDIBLE ALARMS AND AUTOMATIC DEVICES.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Saucon, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania Enacts and Ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Paragraph 5 of Section 1 - Definitions, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5. False Alarm - means any alarm or other signal activated by an automatic protection device, or any warning signal audible outside of the structure to which it is attached, or any signal given from a residential sensory device, to which police or firemen respond, which is not the result of weather extremes, burglary, fire, robbery or similar emergency or a detectable attempted entry.

SECTION II. Paragraph 1 of Section 7 - Penalties and Remedies for Violation, is amended to read as follows:

- 1.(A) If more than three (3) false alarms, as defined above, are given from any such Alarm System or Automatic Protection Device, in a calendar year, the owner shall pay a fine as follows:
 1. For the first offense (fourth false alarm) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), if paid within ten (10) days of notice of violation.
 2. For the second offense (fifth false alarm) Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), if paid within ten (10) days of notice of violation.
 3. For the third offense (sixth false alarm) Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00), if paid within ten (10) days of notice of violation.

4. For the fourth offense (seventh false alarm) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), if paid within ten (10) days of notice of violation.
5. For the fifth offense, and all subsequent offenses, One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) for each offense, if paid within ten (10) days of notice of violation.

(B) Failure to pay and/or respond within ten (10) days, will result in the issuance of a Citation and a fine, if convicted, in the amount set forth above for the specific number of the violation, plus costs of filings.
