- d. Mr. Leonard reviewed the information packet from the Greater Lehigh Valley Food Truck Alliance on Tips for "How Many Food Trucks to Hire". The general guideline is one truck per 200-300 attendees.
- e. The Commission reviewed 2 Memorial Tree Applications; Babio and Cole. Both applications were approved. There is no longer any room left at the Community Park, the trees will be planed at the new Hopewell Park when available.

f. The Commission discussed Family Movie Night that will be held on August 16th. Suggestions for the movie will be forthcoming and the commission will seek out possible partners for food and beverage service.
