### **Checklist for Completing Fireworks Display Permit Application**

- Complete Application for Fireworks Display Permit. Failure to provide all information requested will result in denial of application.
- Applicant must be at least 21 years of age. Proof of age in the form of a driver's license or passport must be provided at time of application. (Township will make copy of driver's license or passport to attach to application).
- Applicant or pyrotechnician must provide Bond in the amount of \$50,000 conditioned for the payment of all damages relating to the display. The Bond must be filed with the Township. The terms of the bond are subject to Township approval.
- Applicant or pyrotechnician must provide to the Township a Certificate of Insurance evidencing General Liability insurance in the amount of One Million Dollars. Insurance coverage must be solely applicable to the specific display / event named in the application. Coverage applicable to other events or operations, generally, will not be accepted. Also, the Certificate of Insurance must name the following individuals/entities as additional insureds: Upper Saucon Township and its Boards, Commissions and Authorities (including the individual members thereof) and their elected and appointed officers, officials, employees, professional consultants and agents. Said insurance shall be primary over any Township insurance.
- Provide documentation the pyrotechnician has attended courses relating to pyrotechnics and has all necessary credentials, licenses and certifications to discharge fireworks in Pennsylvania. This includes any licenses or certifications issued by State and Federal agencies.
- \$250.00 permit application fee. Check should be made payable to "Upper Saucon Township."
- The display must occur between 7 pm and 10 pm and can last no more than 30 minutes.
- The minimum size lot for holding a display is 5 acres. Parcels of contiguous land may be combined to achieve the necessary lot size, however, all owners must agree and apply for the permit.
- Map showing the following information:
  - Areas on property where fireworks will be stored, handled and launched.
  - Distance from fireworks launch site to nearest occupied structure (at least 300 feet required).
  - Distance from fireworks launch site to adjacent property lines (at least 200 feet required).
- Application has been signed by the applicant, property owner(s) and pyrotechnician.
- Applicant has read and understands Ordinance No. 164 and applicable State statutes governing fireworks.
