# **DIRECTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Review Agenda for Zoning Hearing Board meeting on January 6, 2021
The Board reviewed the following two appeals on the docket for the January 6, 2021 Zoning Hearing Board meeting:

- Appeal No. 2020-13 The Special Exception application of Tree Trails Adventures to establish an aerial ropes course on the property at the southwest corner of Center Valley Parkway and Old Bethlehem Pike.
- Appeal No. 2020-14 The application of Jeffrey and Heather Obrzut to convert an existing detached garage into an Integrated Family Dwelling Unit on the property at 3351 / 3361 Jacoby Road.

It was the determined that Appeal No. 2020-14 concerning the property at 3351 / 3361 Jacoby Road involves a routine matter that can be handled by the Zoning Hearing Board without input from the Board of Supervisors.

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding Appeal No. 2020-13, the Special Exception application of Tree Trails Adventures.

Attorney Erich Schock and Andy Worthington were present on behalf of Tree Trails Adventures and addressed the Board regarding Appeal No. 2020-13. Messrs. Schock and Worthington described the ropes course and related improvements proposed on the property at the southwest corner of Center Valley Parkway and Old Bethlehem Pike. Attorney Schock said Tree Trails Adventures would be leasing the property from Lehigh University.

Messrs. Schock and Worthington responded to questions from Board members.

Mr. Worthington said he would work with Lehigh University to preserve and protect the historic resources on the property.

The Board discussed possible conditions that could be attached to any approvals granted by the Zoning Hearing Board relating to Appeal No. 2020-13.

The Board of Supervisors directed Township staff to prepare a list of reasonable conditions to be presented to the Zoning Hearing Board when the appeal of Tree Trails Adventures is considered. The Zoning Hearing Board would ultimately decide whether or not to attach the conditions to any approvals granted.

Request to increase Tax Collector's rate of compensation from \$3.25 per tax bill to \$3.75 per tax bill beginning January 1, 2022

Mr. Beil reviewed a request from Deborah Herstine, Township Tax Collector, to have the Tax Collector's rate of compensation increased from \$3.25 per tax bill to \$3.75 per tax bill. Mr. Beil said the earliest any such increase could go into effect would be January 1, 2022.

A discussion ensued concerning the merits of the Tax Collector's request.

The Board was generally in support of increasing the Tax Collector's rate of compensation to \$3.60 per tax bill, and the Township Manager was directed to place this matter on the next meeting agenda for formal action by the Board.

Procedure for reviewing proposals to lease Tumblebrook Golf Course and associated properties

Mr. Beil said proposals to lease the Tumblebrook Golf Course and associated properties are due on Friday, January 8, 2021. He expects the Township to receive at least two proposals and wanted to know the Board's preference for evaluating the proposals.

The Board referred this matter to the Park, Recreation and Open Space Committee. The Committee was tasked with reviewing the proposals and making a recommendation for consideration by the full Board.

Procedure for reviewing applicants for position of Assistant Director of Roads and Properties Mr. Beil said nine applications have been received for the position of Assistant Director of Roads and Properties. He asked what level of involvement the Board wanted to have in reviewing and interviewing the applicants. He noted the final hiring decision would have to made by the full Board.

The Board referred this matter to the Appointments Review Committee. The Township Manager will conduct the first round of interviews and the Committee will be involved in the second round of interviews. At the conclusion of the second interviews, the Committee will make a recommendation for consideration by the full Board.

# **ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**

Mr. Spaeth suggested the Board consider establishing an Historic Advisory Committee made up of residents interested in identifying and preserving the Township's historic structures and assets.

Mr. Beil mentioned historic preservation typically falls under the purview of the Environmental Advisory Council.

The Board was in favor of getting the Environmental Advisory Council more involved with historic preservation efforts.
